**SUBJECT: NCIUA MEMBER COMPANY ANNUAL HOMEOWNERS REPORT**

The purpose of this bulletin is to inform your company of the annual Homeowners reporting requirements called for under NCGS 58-45-71, which resulted from the passage of House Bill 1305 during the 2009 Session of the North Carolina General Assembly.

Each member company of the North Carolina Insurance Underwriting Association is required to report annually to the Commissioner information with regard to their residential property policy writings in the beach and coastal areas. The DOI has developed a Data Call that must be returned by March 1, 2010. This Call requires the reporting of data for both 2008 and 2009, as the statute specifies that the annual change in amounts also be reported. Future Calls will require only one year of reporting.
